MISSION SPEAKER FATHER MARK CHERRY



Father Mark received his call to the Priesthood later in life after a twenty-year journey in Evangelical Christian denominations.

Returning to the Catholic Church in the fall of 1996, he studied at Franciscan University of Steubenville in 1997/98 before entering St. Augustine Seminary, Toronto in January of 2000. Ordained to the Ministerial Priesthood for the Archdiocese of Halifax-Yarmouth on April 30, 2005 he served as a Parish Priest for 14 years. In addition to his Parish duties, he has served as spiritual chaplain to the Weekend of Grace Women's Conference, Weekend of Grace Men's Retreat and Magnificat Breakfast Women's ministry. He has been spiritual chaplain on many pilgrimages walking in the footsteps of the saints and Our Lord; these include to Rome, Fatima, Lourdes, Lisieux, Assisi, San Giovanni Rotondo and the Holy Land.

Sensing a call to full-time evangelization and healing ministry he was appointed to this ministry full-time in June of 2019 by Archbishop Anthony Mancini. In May 2022, Archbishop Brian Dunn renewed this appointment for another 3 years. Sacred Heart Evangelization and Healing Ministry fulfills its mission through Parish Missions, Retreats, Conferences and Healing Masses. More recently, Father Mark has been invited to lead Priest Retreats in the Atlantic Region. Father Mark has passion for sharing the life transforming love and power of Jesus Christ through anointed preaching and teaching. His desire is to see people set free, healed, lifted up and empowered by the Holy Spirit to live out their Divine Mission.
